
The Perth Metropolitan Suicide Prevention Coordinators do not provide a crisis services or interventions for consumers.


AWARENESS INITIATIVES

Youth Aboriginal Mental Health First Aid


The SPC Team will be supporting the delivery of four Youth Aboriginal Mental Health First Aid courses across the Metro:

There were amazing events all over Perth Metropolitan area including:

- Perth Inner City Youth Service (PICYS) community wellness day with self-care activities, games and food held in the park in West Leederville.
- In Yanchep a games morning team and Mental Health chat was delivered for seniors.
- MHW Pharmacy 777 and SPC teamed up to deliver a MHW walk and morning team.
- Yogaziet delivered children/Youth wellbeing workshops during Mental Health Week at selected schools.
- For RUOK day SPC worked with the City Wanneroo to deliver 4 activities at each of their youth centres Hainsworth, Yanchep, Wanneroo and Clarkson. The participants made R U OK cupcakes and gave out to the community to raise awareness. Staff also talked to participants about good mental health practices.
- RUOK Day was a hit in Mandurah with community engagement activities and especially the cupcakes.
- Presented a PD session on <u>Aftercare Supports Following A Suicide Attempt</u> to 25 Social Workers from Royal Perth Hospital, Bentley Hospital, and Midland Hospital. Feedback was very positive, with social workers requesting more booklets to distribute through the appropriate discharge packs.
- Project305 Suicide Prevention Car Show, as well as 3 local community events over the course of 10 September 2 October 2022. They hosted conversations destignatising accessing mental health supports. Project305 has also been promoting TMH messaging on its Instagram and Facebook pages.
- Gosnells Community Wellbeing Fair for Mental Health Week.
